CONNECTING SERVICES

Passengers from Melbourne for Alice Springs must leave Melbourne two days before departure ex Adelaide, e.g. passengers leaving Adelaide for Alice Springs on Monday must leave Melbourne on Saturday night by the 8.40 p.m. Overland and stay in Adelaide on the Sunday night.

A similar position exists in the southbound direction. Passengers from Alice Springs arrive in Adelaide at 9.50 p.m. Melbourne passengers must remain in Adelaide overnight before proceeding to Melbourne the following evening at 7.00 p.m.

Passengers travelling between Sydney and Alice Springs via Melbourne must also make due allowance in their itinerary for the stopover in Adelaide in each direction.

Passengers travelling between Sydney and Alice Springs on "The Indian-Pacific" must make varying stopovers, depending on the day of travel, at Port Pirie. Details of actual timetables for this service are available from Tourist Bureaux, Railway Interstate Booking Offices or from any of the Commonwealth Railways Offices listed herein.

GENERAL INFORMATION

AVAILABILITY OF TICKETS

Ordinary tickets between Adelaide, Port Pirie, Port Augusta, Marree and Alice Springs :

Single Tickets-14 days;

Return Tickets-2 months.

Ordinary inter-system tickets between other systems :

- Single tickets between adjoining Systems one month;
- Single tickets between three or more Systems three months.

Break of journey is permitted at any station, provided the journey to destination is completed within the periods above mentioned.

LUGGAGE

As the space available for luggage in sleeping compartments is necessarily limited, passengers are advised to take with them in the compartment one suitcase not exceeding 28 inches in length which can be placed in the rack provided and one smaller case (say 14–16 inches). Other luggage should be presented (with rail ticket), at least 30 minutes before the train leaves, for conveyance in the brakevan.

Luggage Checks should be obtained for luggage conveyed in the brakevan. Passengers may "check" their luggage between any of the places at which inter-system tickets are on issue.

Free Allowance :

- Passengers undertaking journeys between Capital Cities—1st Class, 168 lb, Economy, 112 lb.
- Passengers undertaking journeys other than between Capital Cities—1st Class, 112 lb, Economy, 84 lb.

FREIGHTING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Passengers who so desire may arrange to have their motor vehicles carried by rail between Port Augusta or Marree and Alice Springs in either direction. They are advised that the carriage of such vehicles is AT THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER.

The usual procedure for railing motor vehicles over the Central Australia Railway is for the passengers to drive to Port Augusta (approximately 200 miles by good road from Adelaide) and load their car onto the railway truck there.

Arrangements may be made at the same time and office where rail reservations are made. However, at least seven days notice of the intention to rail a motor vehicle is required.
